Concert Details, Fees and Requirements

Please read carefully. Concert registration indicates acceptance of the following terms:

1. A non-refundable participation fee includes the cost of all rehearsal hours and costume fees for a single number. The fee schedule is as follows:

- ▶ **Fully-Enrolled Student:** \$175 (ensemble/large group); \$225 (featured role)*
Includes rehearsals, costume, two show tickets and one DVD of final show
- ▶ **Drop-In Student:** \$250 (ensemble/large group); \$300 (featured role)*
Includes rehearsals and costume
- ▶ **All Students 5 and under:** \$95 (ensemble/large group)*
Includes rehearsals and costume
- ▶ Costume fees for each additional group number (requires faculty approval):
All Students: \$95*

**All fees and balances due by October 3, 2015. Solo and featured performances must be approved. Discounted registration fees must be paid in full at the time of purchase.*

2. **Rehearsals:** Rehearsals for the Winter Concert begin the week of September 7, 2015. A separate Production Schedule will be provided with a detailed listing of all rehearsal dates. In general, all rehearsals take place either before or after a student's regularly scheduled class, or on the weekends for 1 to 2 hours between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

3. **Final Rehearsals & Performance:** In addition to regular rehearsals, production participants are required to attend 4 to 6 all-cast rehearsals at The Center for Contemporary Dance and/or the performance venue, which take place between 7:30 – 9:30 p.m. on Fridays and between 1:00 – 6:00 p.m. on Saturdays in November/December 2015. The final show takes place at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 6, 2015 at Trinity Preparatory School, 5700 Trinity Prep Lane, Winter Park, FL 32792.

4. **Absences:** Students are permitted a total of three (3) absences from rehearsals; students who miss more than three (3) rehearsals may be excused from the Concert without refund.

5. **Class Attendance:** Student performers *must* attend at least one (1) regular class from the current Class Schedule with consistent dedication. This requirement is part of the student's education in professional etiquette and artistic development. Excessive absences from regular classes may result in dismissal from a particular number and/or the production as a whole without refund.

6. **Show Tickets:** The Winter Concert is open to the public with a general admission ticket price of \$12 if purchased in advance and \$15 if purchased at the door. VIP tickets with premium reserved seating are \$25. Excluding VIP seating, children under the age of 4 are not required to have a ticket to attend the performance. Each performer is expected to sell a minimum of ten (10) tickets.

7. **Artistic Considerations:** Though all participants who successfully meet the production requirements are guaranteed a place in the performance, no guarantee is made with respect to the role a student will play or the length of time a student will appear on stage. Due to the evolving nature of art, all roles are subject to change without notice up to the date of the performance.
